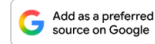

Wren pubs

There are three pubs within the Wren group, the Walmer Castle, the Surprise and the Carpenter's Arms. All are putting on a Burns Night show, with cocktails, craft beers and Scottish dishes available à la carte. Expect the likes of cullen skink, haggis, neeps and tatties, and a raspberry cranachan infused with Scotch and honey. There'll be regular bagpipe performances — check when you book — and every evening will kick off with a traditional address to the haggis. January 19-25.
