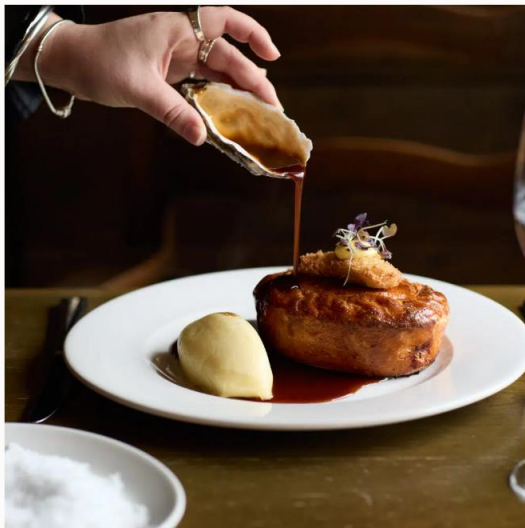


# London's Best Restaurants For 3.1415926535897...

## Walmer Castle, Notting Hill

Notting Hill's Walmer Castle brings us back to pubs. Albeit posh ones. And this Ledbury Road classic is lays on some pie-tastic fare.

At the time of writing, there's a limited-edition beef shin and oyster pie. The novel pairing takes its inspiration from Victorian London, where these were natural pie-fellows. So much so they were referenced by Dickens himself.

If a deep-fried oyster doesn't float your boat then the smart pub runs a rotating 'pie of the day' menu.
